A Lifestyle That Gives

Developing A Heart With Issues

- Today at Valley we have developed many cultural lifestyles.
 - The <u>Word</u> it's importance
 - Discipleship
 - <u>Worship</u>
 - Healing Valley Community Church is healed.

Because we are healed, a culture of giving is **preeminent**

 All of us must understand a giving lifestyle and or culture only happens by developing a <u>heart</u> of giving.

In Matthew 7:1-2. We learned 2 things:

- Judge not and you won't be judged.
- For with the <u>same</u> measure you use, it will be measured back to you.

Then we found in Luke 6:37-38, Jesus added something to the context of Matthew 7:1-2

Matthew 7 – context was judging.

In Luke 6:38, most pastors teach about <u>money</u> – it's really just talking about <u>money</u>.

- 2. Jesus is speaking to the **<u>heart</u>** saying in addition, when you give, it's given back to you <u>more</u>.
 - If you let Me change your <u>heart</u> and then you become a giver, with an attitude thinking, I know God multiplies what I give back to me, but I just want to give, I want to be a giver <u>without</u> expecting in return.
- 3. The reward Jesus is talking about is the right heart.

Question: How do we develop a kingdom heart becoming a giver?

Every one of us must first recognize it is a <u>heart</u> issue and God wants to do a work in our <u>hearts</u>.

Deuteronomy 15 lists some things we must do if we are going to give with a **<u>pure</u>** heart.

Deuteronomy 15:7

Notice if you <u>harden</u> your heart, you will <u>shut</u> your hand.

Deuteronomy 15:8

If we are going to give willingly and not harden our hearts, we must do a few things.

A. First deal with a <u>selfish</u> heart.

Deuteronomy 15:9

God calls selfishness – wickedness

The wicked thought would be - if I gave this to him, there wouldn't be enough <u>time</u> for him to pay it back.

Same principle – don't lend hoping for something in **<u>return</u>**.

Here is the second thing:

B. Deal with a grieving heart

Deuteronomy 15:10

God will bless you in all your <u>works</u> and all to which you put your <u>hand</u>

- God blesses you in all your work when you have a right <u>heart</u>.
 - God blesses when we let Him <u>correct</u> and correctly develop our <u>hearts</u>
 - So don't grieve about what you gave.

God is telling me:

- Selfishness attacks me **<u>before</u>** I give.
- Grieving attacks me <u>after</u> I give.
- 5. God is not concerned with what you **give**, but His concern is will you let Him **work** with your heart?

The reason why we grieve when we give or even lose money – is we think the money was **<u>ours</u>**.

The last 2 weeks, I showed you in scripture that the tithe belongs to God.

Leviticus 27:30

Here is the finality of the revelation!

It **all** belongs to God.

• The tithe is what He **<u>tests</u>** our heart with.

Look at Psalm 24:1

Psalm 24:1

6. <u>Everything</u> I have belongs to God and if God asks me for it, I don't <u>grieve</u>.

It's called stewardship and ownership.

7. God is the **<u>Owner</u>** and we are the <u>steward</u>.

The third thing:

C. Develop a **<u>generous</u>** heart.

Deuteronomy 15:14

Give **<u>over</u>** and **<u>above</u>** when you give.

Here is the fourth thing:

D. Develop a grateful heart.

Deuteronomy 15:15

- 8. If you're going to be a giver, you must <u>remember</u> where you came from and be <u>grateful</u>.
- When it comes to giving, you used to be a <u>slave</u>, so let God build <u>gratitude</u> in your heart.

If you allow God to:

- Deal with your **heart**
- Deal with selfishness
- Deal with grief
- Develop <u>generosity</u>
- Develop gratitude

Luke 6:38 is not the <u>motive</u> for giving – "Give and it will be given to you" – but it is the <u>reward</u>.

Giving is why we are **<u>living</u>**.
