# A Lifestyle That Gives

## Developing A Heart With Issues To Give Over And Above

- When you open your heart, <u>allowing</u> God to deal with the issue of your heart, healing permeates <u>every</u> area of your life.
- 2. We must develop a culture of **giving**, not **getting**.
- 3. You and I in the kingdom of God are **conduits** of God to bring blessings to others in every area of their life.

## Luke 6:37-38

4. The reward of God in giving back to us that's overflowing comes not because we gave, but we gave with the **right** heart.

The overabundant return to you is a reward for a **changed** heart.

Here is my pastoral heart with what we have learned in this series so far:

- Many are in <u>bondage</u>
- Many have strongholds in their life
- Some here, your **marriage** is in trouble
- Your **health** is in trouble

5. When God does a work in your heart and you have a lifestyle of giving, every area of your life will **change**.

Why - because He took selfishness out

\* So you have an enemy, his name is <u>Satan</u>; he hates you and does not want you to give everything to <u>God</u>.

Satan – wants to <u>deceive</u> you and keep you in that <u>stronghold</u>.

 He will give you reasons and even use scripture to try to deceive you like he tempted Jesus and twisted it.

Let me be very frank with you regarding this revelation:

- A year from now you may face a <u>divorce</u>.
- You will be at a **hospital**
- **Family** falls apart

That's how important this window of opportunity is for me.

My goal today – talking about giving that we now will give **over and above**.

1 Chronicles 29:1

1 Chronicles 29:2 - David speaking

## 1 Chronicles 29:3 – see over and above

- David is giving <u>all</u> he just described why:
  - David set his affection on the House of <u>God</u> His <u>kingdom</u>

#### 1 Chronicles 29:4-5

• He gave from his own **special treasure** 

## Matthew 6:21

In verse 5 of 1 Chronicles 29, David says something:

#### 1 Chronicles 29:5b

5...Who then is willing to consecrate himself this day to the Lord?"

David is asking are you <u>willing</u> to consecrate yourself to the House of God?

#### 1 Chronicles 29:6

- They gave willingly

## 1 Chronicles 29:7-9

- Notice willingly with a <u>loyal</u> heart
  - Then he offers a prayer and let me show you one verse.

#### 1 Chronicles 29:14

7. In other words he said, God, we just **gave back** to You what You gave us.

## 1 Chronicles 29:17-18

 It still goes back to the heart of giving <u>willingly</u> to the house of God.

In this giving:

- Don't give under <u>compulsion</u>.
- Don't give under **pressure**.
- Give cheerfully
  - \* Here it is give willingly

Return your tithe, give offerings, give firstfruits, love, be kind, forgive, do not judge – be a **giver** 

Two reasons for this lifestyle of giving:

- The work of God must be done
- Because we need a change in our <u>heart</u>.

## Luke 9:12-17

<u>12</u> baskets full were left

## Luke 9:16

- It doesn't say Jesus <u>multiplied</u> the food, He just looked up to the Father and broke them, and gave them to the disciples.
- 8. The miracle did not happen in the Master's hand, but the miracle happened in the **disciples'** hands.
  - The Master <u>blessed</u> it.
  - It had the **potential** to multiply

Two principles we must believe:

#### Remember:

- A. The first portion is the **redemptive** portion so you have to give to God **first**.
  - 9. Jesus is the only one that has the **power** to bless your giving so it will multiply you have to give God first.
- B. They gave what was left **away** which is over and above the **tithe**.
  - This is the <u>over and above</u> principle.

Again: tithing is not giving because tithing is returning.

We don't start giving until it is over and above.

Remember in Matthew 25 – talents

One given five (made <u>five</u> more), the other two (made <u>two</u> more), and the other one (<u>buried</u> it).

When the master came back:

Five - he said here is what is already yours and **five** more

Master said: <u>well done</u> good and faithful servant

Two – here is what is yours and **two** more

- Master said **well done** good and faithful servant

 God doesn't call <u>maintaining</u> - faithfulness; God calls <u>increasing</u> – faithfulness

One talent – said here is what is already yours.

- Master said <u>unfaithful</u> servant because you gave back to me only what was already mine
- 11. God wants us to go **beyond** tithing.
  - We don't give to get

Family – I'm trying to convince you there is a **better** life to live – it's the life of a **giver**.
