Obedience Is The Key

- Obedience is the key in the area of <u>giving</u> and any other area of life: in our <u>marriage</u>, our <u>health</u>, our <u>spiritual</u> walk.
 - If you want <u>above and beyond</u>, and live a <u>miraculous</u> life, obedience is the key.

John 2:1-5

 Remember verse 5, "Whatever <u>Jesus</u> says to you, do it."

John 2:6-10

Of this story, here is my question:

• Why did Mary go to Jesus when they ran out of wine?

Verse 4 – Woman, what does your concern have to do with Me?

Jesus says: My hour has **<u>not yet</u>** come.

2. Mary must have known Jesus had an **ability** to do something about it.

"Whatever He says to you, do it."

- This is the phrase that has been going over and over in my spirit.

As a pastor, I am only asking you this: Whatever <u>**God**</u> says to you, do it.

This is what jumps out at me.

Mary says: whatever

3. If He says to do it, and you want to see above and beyond, **<u>do</u>** it.

I see 3 things about obedience in the Bible.

A. Obedience can be <u>measured</u>.

John 2:7a

⁷ Jesus said to them, "Fill the waterpots with water."...

John 2:7b

⁷...And they filled them up to the brim.

Every **<u>drop</u>** of water they put in the pots became Heaven's wine.

4. You determine the <u>measure</u> of what God blesses you with.

Luke 6:38

- Whatever <u>measure</u> you give with is what you will get back.
- By my obedience, <u>I determine</u> what comes back.

5. They put in something **<u>natural</u>** and Jesus turned it into the <u>**supernatural**</u>.

In your obedience:

- If you give a <u>little</u>, you'll receive <u>little</u>.
- If you give over and above, you receive <u>over and above</u>.

That is the **<u>kingdom</u>** principle.

Second thing about obedience:

- B. Obedience transforms <u>dead</u> religion into <u>exciting</u> faith.
 - These pots at the wedding were **<u>ceremonial</u>** washing pots for purification.
 - The pots had no spiritual **significance**.

Let me say it this way: There are many believers who are still so excited about Jesus and are full of <u>life</u>, but there are some believers who are Christian <u>fossils</u> – steeped in religion.

- The difference is those full of life are living in **obedience**.

Here is the life of **<u>excitement</u>**: whatever He says, do it.

Obedience transforms **<u>dead</u>** religion into **<u>exciting</u>** faith.

The third thing:

C. Obedience is the key to our heart's **desires**.

This was Jesus <u>first</u> public sign:

6. Turning water into wine was simply blessing a family at their children's wedding with **<u>refreshments</u>**.

This tells me God cares about the things you care about no matter how <u>small</u> it is. Page 3 of 4

Psalm 37:4

Here is the culture of the kingdom of God:

 If you <u>obey</u> God, building <u>His</u> kingdom, He will build your <u>house</u>.

Here are 2 reasons why God will bless you more than you bless yourself:

- Because God has **more** than you do.
- He loves you **more** than you love yourself.

John 3:16

Matthew 6:33

Proverbs 10:22

- There are a lot of people who have <u>a lot</u> of things, but they live in <u>sorrow</u>.
- 7. Jesus is sitting at the table of your desires **waiting** for you to obey Him and do whatever He says.

3 John 2

A prosperous soul is an **<u>obedient</u>** soul.

Jesus was **<u>not</u>** telling Mary, no.

 He was saying: they are not <u>recognizing</u> Me yet – they're not <u>including</u> Me.

She turned to the servants: Do whatever <u>**He**</u> says.

When you give: Do what <u>**He**</u> says.
