The Son was <u>active</u> encountering people in the Old Testament also.

- He appeared to **<u>Abraham</u>** and <u>**Sarah**</u>, and <u>**blessed**</u> them.
- He was the one talking with <u>Moses</u> in the burning bush.

Moses said, what is your name?

He answered, "<u>I AM</u>"

John 8:53-58

- He also <u>wrestled</u> with Jacob.

Jacob then said, "I have seen God face to face."

 Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego <u>danced</u> with Jesus in the fiery furnace.

Daniel 3:25 (NIV)

²⁵ He said, "Look! I see four men walking around in the fire, unbound and unharmed, and the fourth looks like a son of the gods."

* Jesus has had **personal** encounters with mankind for **thousands** of years.

Reason I am excited about today's message:

- This encounter with Paul is after the **ascension** of Christ.

 Jesus' encounter with Paul proves to us we still can have a <u>personal</u> encounter and or <u>relationship</u> with Jesus.

Paul had several encounters with Jesus

Acts 9:1-5

I am going to show you 3 things that happened in Saul's encounter.

- A. Saul received a new **<u>name</u>**.
 - He is called Saul in this passage and for the next 13 years, called <u>Saul</u>.
 - 2. In Acts 13, Saul's name was changed to <u>Paul</u> when he is sent out to fulfill his <u>purpose</u> on this earth.

We don't know if God changed Saul's name, but we do know God has a **<u>habit</u>** of changing names.

Name changing had a **purpose**.

We do know, Saul is his <u>Hebrew</u> name

Paul is his <u>Gentile</u> name.

It's also possible the **<u>disciples</u>** changed his name.

Remember Barnabas, who was on Paul's team? **Disciples** changed his name.

His name was changed from Joses to Barnabas (means son of **encouragement**)

Barnabas' closest friends said, if <u>encouragement</u> has a <u>child</u>, it would be you, Joses, so we will call you Barnabas.

3. God has a <u>new</u> name for you because when you became <u>born again</u>, God <u>changed</u> your name.

Revelation 2:17

- Some of you might say I may not overcome!
- 4. You overcome not by **being good** but through grace.
- You have to stop thinking and living with a <u>works</u> mentality, but a <u>becoming</u> mentality. You overcome because you are in <u>Christ</u> and <u>Jesus Christ</u> has overcome the world.

Ephesians 2:4-10

Here is my question: What is the name that God has for you?

When you are born again, on that white stone will be written a new name that only the one who **<u>received</u>** it will **<u>know</u>** it.

Saul – means demanded death.

He was the guy that went around demanding death for **believers**.

Paul - means little or small

1 Corinthians 15:9-10

- He refers to himself as the **least** of the apostles.

By the way, that is a **<u>kingdom</u>** principle.

Matthew 23:11

Matthew 20:26-28

Why is Paul so amazing?

- <u>27</u> books in the New Testament Paul wrote <u>13</u> for sure. I believe <u>14</u> (complete <u>Hebrews</u> with <u>Luke</u>)
- Most of the theology the church understands about Jesus came from <u>Paul</u>.

Theology:

- Saved by grace
- The **<u>Body</u>** of Christ
- And so <u>much more</u>
- 6. When Paul **took** and **understood** his name, he became the **least**, and God made him **great**.

Knowing who <u>God</u> is, realizing then who <u>you</u> are, and then <u>pinpointing</u> your purpose with the <u>meaning</u> of your <u>new</u> name – you will <u>succeed</u>.
