Wealth At The Tip Of Your Tongue

 Are any words really free or do our words cost something?

Matthew 12:33

Tree – refers to the **heart**Fruit – refers to the **mouth**

Conclusion: Your **heart** is known by what your **mouth** says

Matthew 12:34

The heart produces words

Matthew 12:35-36

Matthew 12:37

 If your <u>heart</u> is changed, then your <u>mouth</u> is changed, which means your <u>words</u> will change.

The opposite of that is if your heart is not changed, your mouth will **never change**.

David said:

Psalm 19:14

Proverbs 6:2

The power of life and death are in the tongue.

So, are any of our words free?

Let me give you 3 lies Satan tells us about our words.

A. We have the right of **free speech**

There is a difference between the kingdom of <u>God</u> and <u>man's</u> kingdom.

• Free speech – Biblically

Does it mean I can say anything I want? Any time I want, and not be accountable for it?

Does it mean God will not call me into account for my words?

No - all of our words cost!

* I do need to learn to **control** my tongue if I want kingdom of **heaven** results.

Church: There is a **spiritual battle** of words happening right now in your life.

- * We cannot say anything we want, we are still **accountable** to god.
- * Just because it's <u>legal</u>, it doesn't mean it's <u>okay</u> with **God**.

Bottom line:

- There is a <u>higher</u> law than an American <u>law</u>.
- There is a <u>higher</u> justice than America's <u>social justice</u>.

It is **God's** law.

Psalm 141:3 - pray this every morning

* If you ever start a conversation with, "I probably shouldn't say this" – Don't say it

Psalm 39:1

How about this statement – second thing Satan lies to us.

"Hey I'm just kidding, don't be so sensitive."

B. Satan tells you, you're **kidding**, go ahead and **say** it.

Proverbs 26:18-19

- On the tip of your tongue, you have a <u>wealth</u> of blessings – be a <u>blessing</u>
- God gave us the ability to <u>communicate</u> our <u>heart</u>.

It is the **<u>creative</u>** ability to change things around you.

3. Wealth is at the <u>tip</u> of your tongue, so <u>develop</u> your <u>heart</u>.

Question: How do you get rid of bad words?

Answer: Forgiveness

- If you want to get rid of bad words that you have spoken, you <u>ask for</u> forgiveness. If someone has spoken them to you, in your heart from your mouth, <u>give</u> forgiveness.
- A bad <u>tree</u> produces bad <u>fruit</u>, and bad <u>fruit</u> has bad <u>seeds</u>, when <u>not changed</u>, will produce a bad <u>forest</u>.

The third thing Satan says that's a lie:

C. As soon as our words are **forgotten**, the **influence** of our words are **gone**.

Words are **eternal**.

- * Words **hurt** people and can **encourage** people.
 - Verbal abuse is **manipulation**.
- 6. Church family, do not take the gift God has given you to rip people apart; **build them up**.
- 7. Good words last forever also.

2 timothy 1:3 (ERV) – Paul said to Timothy

³I always remember you in my prayers day and night. And in these prayers I thank God for you...

The word, remember – in the Greek

The root definition of the Greek word translated "remember" means: a **graveyard monument**.

A monument – it's a **memorial** to someone's **life**.

8. Paul was saying, my prayers are **building** a statue of your need before God.

This truth tells us this:

A grandmother can build a **monument** before God of her grandchildren and she can die, and 20 years later, those grandchildren can **come to Christ**.

The wealth of your words **changes lives**.

Bad words <u>last</u>, but good words <u>last</u> too.
