# **Proclaiming Your Future**

## Every Word Has Significance

#### Proverbs 18:20

 The <u>quality</u> of life that you live depends on what you <u>say</u>.

#### Proverbs 18:21

This is why our words are so consequential:

The reason is that we were created in the image of a <u>creative</u>, <u>speaking</u> God.

#### Genesis 2:7b

7 ... (God) breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Paraphrase – man became **speaking** spirits

There is something **<u>creative</u>** about our **<u>speaking</u>**.

 In this creativity, the Bible doesn't say in the creating with our <u>words</u>, our power is even close to <u>God</u> creating.

Verse 21 does say: death and life are in the power of our **tongues**.

If Proverbs 18:21 is true, we need to learn how to <u>control</u> our tongue.

How many problems we could fix in our **body** if we can fix our **mouths**.

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#### James 3:2-6

Here is my focus:

 I am not saying we need to get <u>God</u> in agreement with our <u>words</u>, I am saying we need to get our <u>words</u> in agreement with <u>God</u>.

Let me give you two things today about our words:

#### A. Words connect us to God.

5. Words are <u>how</u> God comes from the <u>spiritual</u> realm where <u>He</u> lives, into the <u>natural</u> realm where <u>we</u> live.

#### John 4:24

- Words are the <u>vehicle</u> or the <u>bridge</u> to get from the <u>spiritual</u> to the <u>natural</u> – or the <u>natural</u> to the <u>spiritual</u>.
- Another bridge god uses:
  - We were <u>separated</u> from God.
  - There is an <u>eternal division</u> between God and man which is called <u>sin</u>.
  - A Holy God cannot **fellowship** with sin.

Question: How did God connect with us from the spiritual to the natural?

Answer: John 1:1, 14

## John 1:1, 14

- So the <u>spiritual</u> word became <u>natural</u>.
- He, the **Word** became **flesh**.

#### Psalm 107:20

Our God is constantly <u>bridging</u> that gap with His Word.

#### Psalm 100:4

Singing - words

Thankful - heart attitude

- The reason Satan doesn't want you to be a <u>praiser</u> or <u>worshipper</u> is because he knows that's how you reach God is through <u>words</u>.
  - Praise <u>faith</u>
  - Grumbling <u>unbelief</u>

So we not only praise, but we **pray** and that is **talking** to God.

Question: Why does God want us to pray day and night – pray in the spirit <u>always</u> and to pray without <u>ceasing</u>?

This keeps us **connected** to God.

**<u>Praise</u>** and <u>**prayer**</u> keeps us connected.

Not in <u>relationship</u> – that is through the <u>blood</u> of Jesus Christ.

This is so important:

 Satan cannot harm us, but he tries to <u>deceive</u> us so we will harm <u>ourselves</u>.

He is trying to get you to turn your mouth **against** yourself and **destroy** yourself.

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Here is the goal of Satan's attack:

8. Satan uses words to <u>deceive</u> you so you won't be a praiser, a pray-er, and live your life not being <u>thankful</u>.

This <u>disconnects</u> you from <u>fellowship</u> with God.

#### Romans 10:8-10, 13

How does a person get saved?

He walks the <u>bridge</u> of the <u>confession</u> of the Lord Jesus Christ.

9. Words get you from the <u>natural</u> to the <u>spiritual</u>; from **Hell** to **Heaven**, and/or **life** and **death**.

#### Matthew 12:31-32

#### Matthew 12:33

The tree is the **heart**.

The fruit is the **mouth**.

He says if you have a bad tree (<u>heart</u>), you will have bad fruit (<u>mouth</u>)

#### Matthew 12:34

 If you have an <u>evil</u> heart, you can't speak <u>good</u> things.

#### Matthew 12:35

### Matthew 12:36-37

The reason you are speaking what you are is because your heart is <u>hard</u> towards the Holy Spirit, and the Holy Spirit <u>draws</u> you to God.

10. Scripture constantly ties the **heart** with the **mouth**.

The unpardonable sin is a hard heart which comes out of the mouth in the <u>rejection</u> of Jesus Christ.

How significant are our words:

#### Matthew 12:36

I think God **remembers** all our **words** – watch this:

#### Hebrews 8:12

God is <u>recording</u> but He has an <u>erase</u> button – it's called the <u>blood</u> of Jesus Christ through <u>grace</u>.

11. Even as a believer, my words should be so **significant** to me because my works will be **tried**.

Second thing I want to show you:

B. Words **connect** us to each other.

#### Proverbs 18:20-22

It's amazing verse 21 and 22 are together.

- 12. Your marriage will never be any **better** than your **mouth**.
  - If you want a great <u>marriage</u>, make it with your <u>mouth</u>.
  - If you want great <u>kids</u>, make them with your <u>mouth</u>.
    - \* Speak <u>life</u> over those around you, not <u>death</u>.

13. Start aligning your mouth/words with the Word of God. Begin praising God for the person God created them to be.

To encourage means to en-courage – put **courage** in

## Ephesians 5:25-26

Every time I <u>raise</u> the standard of my mouth, more people get <u>ministered</u> to.

You are determining the **<u>quality</u>** of life that you live by what's in your **<u>heart</u>** that comes out of your **<u>mouth</u>**.

If you have **blown up** a bridge with your **words** – it's your **words** that will **rebuild** the bridge.
