# Proclaiming Your Future

## Heaven's Language (Part 2)

- The <u>quality</u> of life that you live depends on what you <u>say</u>.
  - We are learning how to **restructure** our mouths.

#### Exodus 4:10-12

- 2. God said, if you will give me your **mouth**, I will **teach** you what to say.
- The Lord is <u>restoring</u> to the Church, the <u>baptism</u> of the Holy Spirit with an <u>anointing</u> and power of the Holy Spirit with a prayer <u>language</u>.

### Acts 2:1-4

Let's continue with truths in scripture regarding this prayer language:

#### A. It's a language

#### Acts 2:5-6

Second truth:

B. The prayer language is a language of the Spirit

## 1 Corinthians 14:2, 14-15

When you **<u>submit</u>** your tongue to God, you open your mouth, and by <u>faith</u>, begin to speak and <u>let</u> God use your tongue.

- Everything is by **<u>faith</u>**.

It is the language of the **Spirit**.

## Ephesians 6:10-17

Verse 18 – must stop at verse 17

#### Ephesians 6:18a

<sup>18</sup> praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit...

When you pray in **tongues**, you are praying in the **Spirit**.

4. Is it possible you are losing battles because you are not putting on the **whole** armor of God?

Here is the 3<sup>rd</sup> truth:

C. It's the language that **builds** us up.

### Jude 1:20

- According to verse 20, how do you build your spirit?

Answer: Praying in the Holy Spirit

Look back at 1 Corinthians 14:4

### 1 Corinthians 14:4

5. It's good to edify **yourself**, but when you go to Church, don't greet each other in **tongues**.

## 1 Corinthians 14:5a

<sup>5</sup>I wish you all spoke with tongues, but even more that you prophesied...

- We must understand Paul penned these verses but the Holy Spirit **<u>authored</u>** them.
- 6. If you have any <u>hang-ups</u> regarding speaking or praying in tongues, you've got to get over it.

## 1 Corinthians 14:5b

<sup>5</sup>...for he who prophesies *is* greater than he who speaks with tongues, unless...

Unless what?

Answer:

## 1 Corinthians 14:5c

5...unless indeed he interprets, that the church may be edified.

 When the tongue is <u>interpreted</u>, the tongue is equal to <u>prophecy</u> because the Church is <u>edified</u>.

## 1 Corinthians 14:18

<sup>18</sup>I thank my God I speak with tongues more than you all;

Apostle Paul is saying this

## 1 Corinthians 14:39-40

\* We have focused so long on the "decently and in order" part we forgot it said, "let all things be <u>done</u>."

Look at verse 39:

## 1 Corinthians 14:39b

<sup>39</sup>...and do not forbid to speak with tongues.

## Mark 16:17

In this verse, what is the requirement for casting out demons and speaking in tongues?

#### Answer: to **believe**

Here is the fourth truth:

D. It is a **pure** language

#### Genesis 11:1

This is the story of the Tower of **<u>Babel</u>**.

Question: The whole earth had one language – what language was it?

Another question: What language did Adam and Eve speak in the garden?

- \* The whole earth has <u>one</u> language.
- \* They start building a **tower**.

#### Genesis 11:5-6

#### Genesis 11:7-9

8. From there, the Lord created all the **languages**.

Here it is what I saw:

- They are trying to build a tower to **<u>Heaven</u>**.
- Why didn't God let them?

Answer: Because they **<u>could</u>** do it.

- God says, let's go down and take this language away from them. They have the language of Adam and Eve and now it's a fallen language or fallen <u>nature</u>.
- Now do you remember this scripture?

## Zephaniah 3:9

\* Notice: He said He will **<u>restore</u>** it.

God is **restoring** the language that nothing is **impossible**.

\* Every language in the world has **profanity**, but one does not.

It is the language of **<u>Heaven</u>**.

God said: I took it away, now I'm **giving** it back.

- The book of Zephaniah speaks of the Messiah coming
  not the rapture, but coming to <u>earth</u>.
  - They had a fallen nature and the language was taken away for that <u>reason</u>.
- 10. The Messiah will come and <u>redeem</u> them and once that happens, I'll change their nature and give the language back and it will make them <u>one</u> and nothing they propose to do will be <u>withheld</u> from them.

## Zephaniah 3:9

Last 3 words – to serve him "with <u>one accord</u>"

### Acts 2:1

Reminder:

- The prayer language may sound **funny**
- But **open** your mouth and **move** your tongue
- Uttering sounds and **yielding** your tongue
- It is a language
- It is the language of the Holy Spirit
- It <u>builds</u> you up and it's <u>pure</u>
