# Heaven's Baptism Continued

Last week: 3 Baptisms

- The Baptism in <u>salvation</u> being baptized into the Body of Christ.
- The Baptism in <u>water</u>
- The Baptism in the <u>Holy Spirit</u>

Also after being born again to walk in the Holy Spirit's power.

- Be <u>water</u> baptized
- Be baptized in the Holy Spirit

Let's read John 1:32-33 again

#### John 1:32-33

1. When Jesus came out of the water, the Holy Spirit ascended on him like a dove and then **remained**.

The Holy Spirit baptism is when He comes **<u>upon</u>** you and then **<u>remains</u>**.

- Wait for the promise of the **<u>Father</u>** 

Acts 1:5

Matthew 28:18-20

2. Disciple others and water baptize them is the Great Commission but these are not Jesus' **<u>last</u>** words.

Luke 24 and Acts 1 are actually the **<u>last</u>** words of Jesus.

Jesus' last words were to **stay**.

 Jesus' last words were to <u>stay</u> and get the <u>power</u> of the Holy Spirit, and once you do, then you <u>go</u>.

# Luke 24:49

Stay until you get the promise!

• The promise is the **<u>Baptism</u>** of the Holy Spirit

As we explained last week the 3 baptisms, I want you to see them working in the book of Acts.

# Acts 2:37

See if you can see the 3 baptisms:

#### Acts 2:38

<sup>38</sup> Then Peter said to them, "Repent (that's <u>salvation</u>), and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission (<u>cancelling</u> of debt) of sins; (speaks of <u>water</u> baptism) and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit (<u>Spirit</u> baptism.

# **<u>Repent</u>** – be <u>baptized</u> – baptized in the <u>Holy Spirit</u>

#### Acts 2:39

\* We are the **<u>far off</u>** – it's **your** promise too.

Acts 8:5-8

# Acts 8:12

<sup>12</sup> But when they believed (<u>salvation</u>) Philip as he preached the things concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women were baptized (<u>water</u> baptism).

#### Acts 8:14-15

Holy Spirit baptism

#### Acts 8:16-18

Acts 19:1-6 Many years after Acts 2

# The 3 Baptisms

Verse 4	repentance – <u>salvation</u>	

- Verse 5 Baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus <u>water</u> baptism
- Verse 6 Holy Spirit baptism

#### Acts 19:6

The Bible is **literal**, but there are also **symbols** and **figurative** types

# 1 John 5:7

- Father - the Son - the Holy Spirit

What do they bear witness to?

Answer: they bear witness to the supernatural

# 1 John 5:8

- When you get saved, you become a <u>new</u> person and you're on your way to <u>Heaven</u>.
- When you get water baptized, the old man is **cut off** in the water of baptism

Romans 6 and Colossians 2 says God does a cutting of the flesh – a work in your <u>heart</u>

- When you recognize the revelation of water baptism, God does a work in your <u>heart</u> and the old man is <u>cut off</u>.
- When I get baptized in the Spirit, I get power to walk in the <u>new</u> life salvation has given.

Look at the complete work of God.

- A. When I get saved, I became a <u>**new**</u> person.
- B. When I get water baptized, the <u>old</u> person <u>stays</u> in the water and is <u>cut off</u>.
- C. When I get baptized in the Spirit, I receive **power** to walk in the **new**.
- The reason we have some <u>defeated</u> Christians is because they were baptized as a <u>child</u> and the old man was never <u>cut off</u> even though they were saved, and they don't get baptized in the <u>Spirit</u>.

I want to now show you about the Kingdom of God that's  $\underline{\mathbf{in}}$  you.

# John 3:3

 The kingdom of God represents spiritually an overcoming life of a believer

Kingdom – is 2 words: <u>king</u> – <u>dominion</u>

Means: the <u>king's dominion</u> Page 4 of 6 The disciples asked Jesus where is the kingdom of God?

Jesus answered: the kingdom of God is <u>within</u> you.

# John 3:3

Opposite: if you get born again, you can <u>see</u> the overcoming Christian life but he didn't say you can <u>enter</u> it.

# John 3:4-5

Verse 5 – opposite – water baptism and Spirit baptism **allows** you to enter the overcoming Christian life.

# Genesis 12:1

Represents **salvation** in Abram's life

- God called him **<u>out</u>** of the world, and said be a <u>**separate**</u> people.

# Genesis 15:17

# Genesis 15:18a

<sup>18</sup> On the same day the Lord made a covenant with Abram...

Represents <u>water</u> baptism!

Why – there was a **<u>cutting away</u>** of the flesh and a **<u>passing</u>** through

 There was another time God saved His people by the <u>blood</u> of the lamb. God <u>cut</u> something for them to pass through the Red Sea.

# 1 Corinthians 10:1-2

- <u>Water</u> baptism
- By the way, in water baptism, the <u>old</u> man is left in the water and when you go back to the Red Sea, they crossed and the <u>enemy</u> was left in the water or <u>cut off</u>.

Right after the crossing of the Red Sea, the <u>cloud</u> descended on them.

The cloud represents the **<u>Spirit</u>** of God.

- Then writes the 10 commandments and 3,000 die.

Acts 2 – Holy Spirit comes and writes the law on their hearts, and 3,000 get **<u>saved</u>**.

Spirit baptism with Abram

#### Genesis 17:5

God **added** a letter to Abram's name

 ${\rm H-the}$  equivalent of the English letter,  ${\rm H-in}$  the Hebrew equals -  $\underline{\rm spirit}$ 

A **<u>type</u>** of Spirit baptism

Genesis 17:15

# 1 Corinthians 10:1

#### 1 Corinthians 10:2

<sup>2</sup> all were baptized into Moses (Israel's type of <u>Christ</u> – <u>salvation</u>) in the cloud (a type of the <u>Spirit</u>) and in the sea (a type of <u>water</u> baptism)
