Proclaiming Your Future

Heaven's Language

- Last week, we talked about <u>submitting</u> our tongues to the Holy Spirit.
- Today, we will talk about <u>Heaven's</u> language called, praying in the <u>Spirit</u>.

Question: Why is there so much **controversy** about **Heaven's** language?

The Devil knows the **power** of this language.

- Truth is being restored to the Church and it began with the <u>Reformation</u>.
- There were the Dark Ages, ages for <u>hundreds</u> of years in the Church.
- The number one reason is the Church took the <u>Bible</u> out of the hands of people.
 - 1. The first truth restored to the Church was **justification** by **faith**.
 - All the truths being restored have always been <u>true</u>, but through <u>lack</u> of the Word of God, they were <u>lost</u>.
 - Another truth being restored in the Church is the <u>Baptism</u> of the Holy Spirit or the <u>anointing</u> and the <u>power</u> of the Holy Spirit.

This truth also speaks of a **<u>personal relationship</u>** with the Holy Spirit.

When the Holy Spirit was poured out in Acts 2 –
3,000 got saved on the first day.

5,000 got saved on the second day

As the truth of the Holy Spirit began to unfold

- A personal prayer **language** was revealed again
- Personal prayer language it is where your spirit can pray to God, it's part of the <u>armor</u> of God and it <u>builds</u> you up and <u>strengthens</u> you.

Acts 2:1

When the Day of Pentecost had fully come... (Pentecost means <u>50th</u> or <u>50th</u> day after Passover Feast), they were all with one accord in one place

Acts 2:2

Acts 2:3

³ Then there appeared to them divided tongues (<u>different</u> or <u>diverse</u> types of tongues, as of fire, and *one* sat upon each of them.

Acts 2:4

⁴ And they were all filled (<u>120</u>) with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Remember what God told Moses?

Exodus 4:11-12

Jesus told them: make sure you don't <u>leave</u>
Jerusalem until you get this

Why – because when you get this, you're going to have **power** that you need.

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5. So when the Holy Spirit comes, they begin to speak in **tongues**.

Acts 10:44-46

Let me be very clear what the gift of the Holy Spirit was and is!

6. The gift of the Holy Spirit is the **Holy Spirit**, not **tongues**.

Acts 19:6

Let me give you some truths regarding the Holy Spirit and what is given to us.

A. It is a language.

Acts 2:5-6

1 Corinthians 13:1

Though I speak with the tongues (glossolalia, or the <u>language</u>) of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal.

It says – the tongues of **men** and **angels**

- 7. Paul is saying I speak in tongues and it's a language spoken by **men** and of **angels**.
 - When a child begins to speak a language, does he speak it fluently the <u>first</u> day?
 - * Many of you have a second language did you speak it fluently the <u>first</u> day?

The answer is **no**! You **learned** it.

What I am getting to is there are some myths about tongues we need to correct.

 First – is when you get tongues, you speak it <u>fluently</u>; it's <u>perfect</u> and you have a <u>full</u> vocabulary.

No, you don't; it is a language you **learn**.

Second myth about the Heavenly language

• You can't **control** it.

Is there any other gift like that from God you cannot control?

Answer: No

What am I trying to say?

Answer: You have to put some **effort** into functioning in gifts God gives you.

8. Praying in a prayer language you do it by **faith**.

Let's go back to some truths:

B. The prayer language is a language of the **spirit**.

1 Corinthians 14:2

Notice in the Spirit, he speaks **mysteries**.

That's why no one understands it, but the **Spirit** does.

1 Corinthians 14:14

1 Corinthians 14:15

15 What is the conclusion then? I will pray with the spirit (tongues), and I will also pray with the understanding (English, Spanish). I will sing with the spirit (tongues), and I will also sing with the understanding (English, Spanish).

Conclusion:

- If I pray in a **tongue**, it's my **spirit** that prays.
- Praying in a tongue, my understanding is **unfruitful**.
- Your understanding is your <u>mind</u> which is part of your <u>soul</u>.
 - 9. I am going to pray in the **Spirit** and I'm going to pray in my **understanding**.

When you pray in the Spirit – your **spirit** prays.

When you pray in the understanding – your **soul** prays.

* When you <u>submit</u> your tongue to God, you open your mouth and begin to <u>speak</u> and let God use your <u>tongue</u>.

Be **baptized** in the Holy Spirit and move your mouth with **words** the Holy Spirit gives you.
