- Faith is not **blind** and it's not **deaf**.
 - God asks us to step out on His <u>Word</u>; He asks us to step out on His <u>vision</u> on what He <u>shows</u> us and <u>speaks</u> to us.

Scripture says: "faith is the evidence of things not seen"

You don't see it in the **<u>natural</u>**, but you see it in the **<u>spiritual</u>**.

- 2. Faith is: you see or hear something in the spiritual and God asks you to believe it and then step out with <u>corresponding</u> action.
 - Faith to me: is God draws back the curtains of eternity and gives us a <u>glimpse</u> of the future and we begin to walk toward that <u>glimpse</u> or <u>vision</u>.

Hebrews 11:8-10

So today: let me give you 4 actions we need to do if we are going to walk by faith.

A. Obeying

Verse 8 says, "Abraham **<u>obeyed</u>** when he was called to go out to the place"

 If you are going to walk by faith, you have to <u>obey</u> – not what you see in the natural, but the picture or place God showed you or spoke about <u>spiritually</u>.

We have a \underline{window} of opportunity now to \underline{grow} and $\underline{fulfill}$ our destiny.

4. When God spoke, Abraham <u>obeyed</u> and when he <u>obeyed</u>, God <u>moved</u>.

The second action:

B. Dwelling

Hebrews 11:9a

⁹By faith he dwelt in the land...

Dwelt in the land – means – there was a **<u>commitment</u>** to what God said.

Here are two questions I get answered when I counsel people regarding their marriage:

- How committed to **<u>the Lord</u>** are you?
- How committed to your **marriage** are you?

Answer: If you're not committed, it will **<u>never work</u>**.

Genesis 35:1a

Then God said to Jacob, "Arise, go up to Bethel and <u>dwell</u> there...

- Make a commitment

Genesis 35:1b

... and <u>make an altar</u> there to God, who appeared to you when you fled from the face of Esau your brother."

Let me show you what God said – **prayer**

- A prayer alter is a <u>lifestyle</u> where we draw the <u>presence</u> of God and push back the spiritual darkness to see <u>transformation</u> come into lives and lands.
- 6. The foundation of prayer is the **<u>Word</u>** of God.

The third action is:

C. Judging

- Every one of us make **judgments** every day.
- We have to make <u>decisions</u> based on what God is saying every day.

Look at the judgments Abraham and Sarah made:

Hebrews 11:9-10

Hebrews 11:11

- Because she judged <u>well</u>, she received the strength to receive the seed by judging God <u>faithful</u> to the promise.
 - Faith is judging God faithful
 - Doubt is judging God unfaithful
- 8. You make judgments <u>for</u> or <u>against</u> God every day of your life.
 - You either judge Him <u>faithful</u> to His Word or judge He is <u>unfaithful</u> to what He said (<u>promised</u>)

By this judgement, you set your **course**.

Here is the fourth action:

D. Concluding

Hebrews 11:17-18

Hebrews 11:19

It says concluding:

9. If you walk by faith, it will lead you to make <u>conclusions</u> of your future.

You need to understand:

- You already made conclusions about your **marriage**.

Either by faith (based on God's **promises**, Word, or by doubt (based on **natural** circumstances)

Question: How many things have you already concluded that you will fail, get sick, etc.?

Let me conclude with Deuteronomy 11:18-32

Deuteronomy 11:18-32
