Don't Ever Forget

Happy New You

* I am so amazed how <u>easy</u> it is to have New Year's resolutions.

My thought is this: For years, I was really shallow in setting plans and goals for the future.

I wondered what it would be like if we who serve God did something completely <u>different</u>.

But in addition to those resolutions:

- Can we think about spiritual things because God has a very <u>specific</u> and high <u>purpose</u> for your life.
 - God's purpose will never be seen or understood outside of a <u>relationship</u> with Him.

This morning, I want to give you two practical things that are very attainable to be added to your New Year's resolutions.

Here is the first:

A. That you plan to love Jesus **more**.

As you turn, let me explain the difference between a <u>resolution</u> and a <u>plan</u>.

- A resolution simply is a **commitment** to a purpose.
- A plan says, this is <u>how</u> I'm going to accomplish this commitment.

Here is one of the greatest deceptions in a Christian life or church today:

- 2. Thinking that spirituality is just one of those things that just sort of happen when we **show up**.
- 3. Each and every one of us need a **plan** to love Jesus more.

Question: What's your plan?

Let me help you and give you a couple of specific things to carry out a plan to love Jesus more.

- First to pray
- 4. Even though prayer is **simple**, it's not that **easy**.

Let me tell about a book I read:

- Written by Leonard Ravinhill died 1994
- Title: Why A Revival Tarries

Page 19 literally ruined me in two statements

- Ministers who do not spend <u>two</u> hours a day in prayer are not worth a dime a dozen. By our <u>attitude</u> towards prayer, we tell God what has begun in the <u>Spirit</u>, we can finish in the <u>flesh</u>.
 - Pastor Ravinhill was not being <u>legalistic</u> with this statement.

It must warrant <u>time</u> with God - His presence, or you will face things you can't <u>handle</u>.

Church family: My life has never been the same by being in God's **presence**.

5. You don't fetch God with **programs** of prayer, God wants **relationship**.

Joshua 1:7-8

Verse 7-8 is not just talking about **financial** prosperity.

6. It is God's will for your life to be one of those people that everything you touch turns to **gold**.

Joshua 1:8

Psalm 1:1-3

Number one is **prayer**.

The second is:

• Meditation on God's Word.

What does that mean?

- Biblical meditation is filling by speaking God's Word; there becomes a focus into the Word of God that your mind and heart becomes filled with the knowledge of God's Word.
 - It is God using your <u>mouth</u> to direct your <u>mind</u> to affect your <u>heart</u>.

Psalm 55:17 - words of David

Daniel 6:10

It's not how <u>long</u> you pray but that you pursue God out of **love**.

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Ephesians 1:17-19 - Paul prays this

Every time you plan to pray or speak God's Word, you must **worship**.

Psalm 100:4

Somebody asked him one day a question:

Mr. Carver, how did you think of 150 uses of the peanut?

Answer: Anything will yield its secrets to you if you **love** it enough.

You cannot find it in a program.

Here is the second resolution:

B. Set your heart on **Heaven**

The Father has arranged a <u>marriage</u> for you.

There is a picture in the Bible.

There are <u>six</u> cases in scripture where someone witnessed <u>Heaven</u> and wrote about what he saw.

The clearest one is found in Revelation 4.

Psalm 84:10

David had seen the **beauty** of God in Heaven.

The only description you can trust is found in scripture.

Revelation 4:1-11

If you become familiar with Heaven, your <u>hearts</u> will change.

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
