# I Must Know: Prayer Works

1. The key to prayer is to **know**, prayer works.

#### Hebrews 11:6

- Faith **pleases** God.
  - In order for prayer to work, you have to have <u>faith</u> and also know faith is not just believing, faith is <u>knowing</u>.

### 1 John 5:14-15

Notice in the two scriptures:

- There are two "if's"
- There also are two "know's"

Let's look at the first "if" in verse 14:

- If we ask anything according to His will

The second "if" in verse 15:

- And **if** we know that He hears us
- 3. Any time you see the word, "if" in the Bible, it's a **condition**.
- We also must understand in the Bible there are promises stated that are absolutely <u>unconditional</u> no matter what you do, God will never <u>break</u> the promise.

# 2 Timothy 2:12-13

- Example regarding the covenant with Israel.
  - God says, I want you to **do** all My law.
  - I don't want you to ever mess up.

And Israel foolishly said, Okay we will do this and never make a **mistake**; we will enter into the covenant with you.

Now God comes in the New Covenant saying, you entered into this covenant saying, you will never make a mistake → but **you did**.

I'm going to come and fulfill <u>your</u> part of the covenant – born a man, live without sin, and be the perfect sacrifice for <u>you</u> and your <u>mess up</u>.

Again, here it is in 2 Timothy 2:12-13, even if you deny Him and totally messed up, He **cannot** deny Himself.

- 5. The Lord cannot break covenant with Himself; that is the New Covenant so you are **complete** in Him.
  - So there are promises that are <u>unconditional</u>.

He will never leave you nor forsake you  $\rightarrow$  but there are promises that are **conditional**.

Go back to 1 John 5:14

# 1 John 5:14

<sup>14</sup> Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that <u>if we ask anything according to His will</u>, He hears us.

We get hung up with this – it causes us to think this way: If it be thy will?

# Here is my first point how prayer works:

A. Know God's will when you pray.

Question: If you're going to have to pray according to His will, what do you have to know?

Answer: You must know His will.

6. It is easy to know God's will because He had men write it down, the **Bible**.

#### 2 Peter 3:9

<sup>9</sup> The Lord is not slack concerning *His* promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing (means, not His <u>will</u>) that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

So, God's will is He wants **everybody** saved.

The word, will – means **desire** 

- Question: How do you get God's will or desire from Heaven to earth?
- Answer: a disciple said, Lord, teach us to pray

Jesus said, this is how you pray:

Lord, let your <u>desires</u> come to pass on earth as it is in <u>Heaven</u>.

- It's up to us to **know** His will and **pray** His will.

Let me show you how prayer works

# Here is the second point on prayer:

#### B. God hears

#### 1 John 5:15

If we know, if you believe, if you have faith that God **hears** you.

Church family: are you noticing a formula?

- If you pray according to God's will/desires and know that He hears you, the prayer is <u>answered</u>.
- 7. If you know praying God's will works, He hears and it works, you know with faith you are not praying in the **air**.

## Let me give you the third point:

C. Know that God **answers** prayer

#### 1 John 5:15

<sup>15</sup> And if we <u>know that He hears us</u>, whatever we ask, <u>we know</u> that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

- We know God's will/desire is His <u>Word</u>
- We know He <u>hears</u> us and <u>answers</u> prayer
- So, we know we have the **petitions**

God <u>hears</u>, He <u>knows</u>, and He <u>answers</u> - when you pray according to His Will which is His <u>Word</u>.

My question is: who are you praying for?
