# Make It Personal

March 8, 2020

• Prayer is **foundational** in the Church.

If you need a breakthrough in your life, stop thinking about the **<u>situation</u>** and get a breakthrough about **<u>prayer</u>**.

1. Prayer is not a **<u>duty</u>**, prayer is a **<u>privilege</u>**.

Prayer is about God wanting to talk with us and it is a privilege to bring our thoughts, struggles, and desires to the <u>**Creator**</u> of the universe.

Here is a simple definition of prayer:

- Prayer is transferring **burdens**.
  - You at times in your life, carry <u>burdens</u> you were not <u>intended</u> to carry.
  - God never intended for you to have a <u>burden</u> of a Christian family, but it is your responsibility to be a <u>Christian</u>.

The stress is we don't carry our burden to God in **prayer**.

#### Matthew 6:34

You need on a **<u>daily</u>** basis to have a **<u>personal</u>**, quiet time with God.

Explanation of a quiet time:

Be quiet!  $\rightarrow$  Stop <u>talking</u> and <u>listen</u> to God. Page 1 of 6 I want to blow away some myths about prayer.

First myth:

• You can only pray from <u>5 am</u> to <u>6 am</u>.

Second myth:

• You must pray at least one hour.

Third myth about personal prayer:

• Your prayer journal must sound like the **<u>Bible</u>**.

When you write your notes, you don't have to write in **King James**.

Let me give you four steps to making your prayer life personal:

- A. **Quiet** your **mind** 
  - \* The battle is in our **minds**.

#### Psalm 131:2

- When your soul is with the Lord (personal prayer), there is a calmness like a child when he is with his mother.
  - The battle is our **minds** which is part of our **soul**.

Psalm 62:1 – David said this

#### Psalm 62:5

- David tells his soul be **<u>quiet</u>** 
  - \* For a few minutes before I pray, I sit and tell my soul to be **<u>quiet</u>** and rebuke any **<u>spiritual</u>** influence.
    - Telling my soul to be with the Holy Spirit.

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Second thing to get you personal with God:

- B. <u>Focus</u> your mind
  - This is where you **worship** the Lord.
    - Sing (no matter how **<u>bad</u>** it is)

#### 1 Samuel 16:7b

7... For the Lord does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."

How you reach men is the **<u>outward</u>** appearance with **<u>excellence</u>**.

How you reach God is with the *heart*.

- 5. God not only **looks** at the heart, but God **listens** to the heart.
  - I'm not trying to change theology, but is it possible
    God doesn't hear our <u>voice</u> He hears our <u>heart</u>.

Out of the abundance of the **<u>heart</u>**, the mouth speaks.

### John 4:24

- I promise you, God will give you a song for <u>each</u> day Church <u>sing</u>
  - 6. The song you sing will be the <u>key</u> to the Holy of Holies' secret place for you.
    - The song focuses you on <u>God</u> and off of your <u>troubles</u>.

### Psalm 100:4

We forget this: entering His presence, it's through <u>worship</u>. Page 3 of 6 Let me show you Michael, Gabriel, and Lucifer.

Michael – oversaw **prayer** 

Gabriel – brings the **Word** of the Lord

Lucifer – before the fall, oversaw worship

Is it possible: plan for our focus

### <u>Prayer</u>

# <u>Worship</u>

# <u>Word</u>

That's why in our services, we do these three things.

\* Most teachings on personal prayer is **pray** and **read** the Word.

We're missing **worship** which is a **<u>foundation</u>** of the Church.

Listen very closely:

When Lucifer was cast out of Heaven, and Jesus restored our relationship and fellowship with God, then gave us the authority, **worship** and its power was given to <u>us</u>. That's why Satan battles worship because it used to be <u>his</u>. Now it's the <u>Church's</u> responsibility.

You want to have an effective, personal prayer life:

# A. <u>Clear</u> your <u>mind</u>

B. <u>Focus</u> your mind through <u>worship</u>

Third:

- C. <u>Pray</u> your mind
  - Simply pray what's on your <u>mind</u> and as we said, on your <u>heart</u>.

Talk to God with what you're **<u>burdened</u>** about – prayer is **<u>transferring</u>** burdens.

- You are not designed to <u>carry</u> burdens so if you come out of prayer still burdened, you didn't pray, you just <u>griped</u>.
- Talk to God the way you would talk to your <u>best friend</u>.

#### Philippians 4:6

<sup>6</sup> Be anxious for <u>nothing</u>, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving (that's <u>worship</u>), let your requests be made known to God;

If you do this, verse 7 says:

### Philippians 4:7

<sup>7</sup> and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

What's the key? Pray about **<u>everything</u>** and **<u>transfer</u>** your burdens.

# Matthew 11:30

Only time Jesus uses this Greek word for **<u>light</u>**.

- It means, light in <u>weight</u>
- But specifically applied to burdens it means <u>relieving</u> them.

# 1 Peter 5:7

- D. <u>Renew</u> your mind
  - To <u>renew</u> your mind is to read the <u>Word</u>.
  - 9. A quiet time is reading what the <u>Holy Spirit</u> asks you to read.
  - 10. Causing your thoughts to **align** with **God's** thoughts.

# Romans 12:2

How are you going to be transformed?

Answer: By **renewing** your mind

### Hebrews 4:12

When I read the Word of God, it <u>discerns</u> the thoughts and intents of my heart.

It **<u>divides</u>** my motives and God's motives

The way I become a man or woman of faith is to know the **<u>Word</u>**.

Church – get **personal** with God and **renew** yourself.
