# He Is A Person

Turn your Bibles to Hebrews 11:6 and let's begin a new series called:

# God Is What!

## Hebrews 11:6

Question: What does this say if we are to have faith? What are we to believe?

Answer: "He is"

 Most say: He is a Rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

This is **true** also, it's the **second** thing you have to believe.

The first thing to believe is that "He is"

Question: He is what?

According to this verse, He is a **Rewarder**.

1. If you're going to receive from God, you are having to believe He is a **Rewarder**.

Here is my premise in this whole series:

- Does it make a difference what you believe about God? Yes
- Will your belief what God is, affect you? Yes
  - \* My job in this series is to explain God!! Or: show you the **attributes** of God.

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2. Whatever you say the **what is**, determines a lot about your success as a Christian in this world.

Here was your gospel:

- God created you to do the <u>right</u> thing
- Because you didn't do the <u>right</u> thing, it made God mad.
- Father God got so <u>mad</u>, He sent His Son to <u>teach</u> us to do the <u>right</u> thing.
- But, that didn't work, so His Son left a book to show us **how** to do the **right** thing.
  - \* So now, you're afraid because when He comes back, He will be really mad.

First, you started off with the wrong supposition (an <u>uncertain</u> belief) thinking God created you to do something <u>right</u>.

- God created us for <u>relationship</u>.
- We really don't worship God, we worship our <u>concept</u> of God.
  - When we pray to God, we pray to our <u>concept</u> of God.
  - We really don't witness God, we witness about our concept of God.
- Always remember your <u>concept</u> of God or what you <u>think</u> He is in your heart really matters.

So let's talk about who He is.

## Hebrews 11:6

He is

What are attributes?

Answer: At – means - **to** 

Tribute – means - something that is **bestowed** to someone it is **due**.

Attribute – to <u>bestow</u> upon someone it's <u>due</u>.

Now, the word tribute comes from the word, **tribe**.

Tribe – means – the distinct <u>characteristic</u> and the distinct character <u>qualities</u> associated with a <u>group</u> of people descending from one <u>person</u>.

God is what! – we will show you God's distinct character **qualities** that separate God from all other **people**.

Listen closely: You and I are a part of God's **tribe**.

- 4. When we talk about the attributes of God, we are also talking about the attributes of the <u>Church</u> because the Church is a group of people descending from one person.
  - The reason you and I can love is because God is <u>love</u> and you and I are created in His <u>image</u> and <u>likeness</u>.

### Exodus 34:6

- "The Lord" is one of His <u>attributes</u>
- The Lord God describes His <u>sovereignty</u>
- Merciful
- Gracious
- Longsuffering
- Abounding in **goodness**
- Abounding in **truth**

Some of God's attributes are incommunicable – you will never be **invisible** 

# 1 Timothy 1:17

But, look at this in 1 Corinthians 15:53

#### 1 Corinthians 15:53

- I am now immortal – **spiritually** 

<u>God</u> is eternal – root word means without <u>beginning</u> <u>We</u> are eternal – meaning without <u>end</u>

- Putting on immortality I have no end
  - Only God is without <u>beginning</u> and without <u>end</u>.

Turn to Galatians 5:22

## Galatians 5:22a

22 But the fruit of the Spirit...

Could say it this way: but the attributes of the God – what comes <u>out</u> of God because God <u>is</u> – what is produced from **one**.

#### Galatians 5:22b-23 - He is

<sup>22</sup> ... love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

I don't produce these attributes – He is; He is the <u>vine</u> I am the <u>branch</u>

 What I have to do is <u>know</u> He is these attributes and abide in <u>Him</u> and these attributes will manifest through me. Go back to verse 19 and see the attributes of Satan

#### Galatians 5:19-21

Let's look at the first attribute we want to cover in this series:

- God is a <u>Person</u> / believe that He is a <u>Person</u>
  - The Bible never refers to God as an **it** or a **thing**.

#### Genesis 1:26

- 6. We are made in the <u>image</u> and <u>likeness</u> of God and we are a **person**. God is not a human but a **person**.
  - He has likes and dislikes
  - He is <u>happy</u> and He is <u>sad</u>
  - He laughs and He cries
  - He has **feelings**
  - He **rejoices** and He can be **grieved**
  - God <u>loves</u> and He <u>hates</u>
  - God forgives and He takes vengeance

That's what a person **does** 

- 7. **God** listens and He **talks**
- 8. You can only have a personal relationship with a **person** 
  - His desire is so strong to <u>relate</u> to all of us. When sin entered the world, He left Heaven and took care of it Himself.

It is so **personal** to Him to wake you up in the morning, walk with you all day, and then kiss you good night.

9. I have a <u>personal</u> relationship with the Creator of the universe and its filled with **intimacy**.

Exodus 20:4 – first 4 commandments is about your **relationship** with God.

#### Exodus 20:4

 God said, don't make a likeness of anything because that means you're worshipping an <u>inanimate</u> object – stating I am not a <u>Person</u>

They made a golden calf – God said, I'm not a **cow** 

God hates evolution – science is saying I am made out of an **animal** 

 Church – I wasn't made out of an amoeba or a monkey, I was created in the image and likeness of <u>God</u>.

#### Psalm 115:4-8

# God is saying:

- Idols have mouths but they can't <u>speak</u> to you like I can.
- They have eyes, but they can't watch <u>you</u> when you go out (they can't watch your <u>children</u> when they go out) – God says: <u>I can</u>
  - \* God is a <u>Person</u> and <u>holds</u> children when they are afraid
- God sits up with mothers in the <u>middle</u> of the night
- He cries every time there is a <u>divorce</u> because He is a Person

Psalm 115 says – I do all those things:

 I <u>speak</u>, <u>feel</u>, <u>see</u>, <u>hear</u>, and go <u>where</u> you are going to go

#### Psalm 115:8

- This says they are **deaf**, **mute**, and blind **spiritually**
- 10. If you worship something other than a person, you won't be able to **see**, **hear**, or **feel** spiritually
  - The more you <u>relate</u> to God as a Person, the more you can touch others with God's heart and thoughts that's the **Holy Spirit**.

#### Ezekiel 12:2

Rebellion and idolatry closes spiritual life and it happens because you don't see – He IS as a **Person** 

The **shortest** verse in the Bible – John 11:35 "Jesus wept"

He IS – Jesus wants to walk with you **every** step of the way
