# God Is What! (His Attributes)

# He Is All

Here is the statement:

Your **<u>concept</u>** of God, or what you think He is in your <u>heart</u>, really matters.

- We first found, "God is a Person" you can <u>relate</u> with Him.
- Last week, we found, "God is good" Good He is His goodness is His <u>motivation</u>

Today: Let's find out: God is <u>All</u>! This comes from a biblical word, OMNI – OMNI – means <u>all</u>

In the Bible, also I have found 3 OMNI's of God:

- OMNI-POTENT
- OMNI-SCIENT

- OMNI-PRESENT

One of my goals for this series is that the truths will become part of your life or will be how you think on a daily basis.

These 3 words tell us God is:

- All-<u>powerful</u>
- All-<u>knowing</u>
- All-<u>present</u>

Let's go deeper in these 3 attributes of God and explain God is what?!

# A. God is **omnipotent**

Definition of omnipotent – God has all **<u>power</u>**, and all **<u>ability</u>** to perform all His decrees.

1. You must understand, it is His **power** that gives life to His other attributes.

In other words:

- If God wasn't all powerful, then His mercy would be <u>feeble</u>.
- If God wasn't all powerful, His promises would be <u>empty</u>.
- You and I would not as scripture says, put our <u>trust</u> and <u>confidence</u> in a God who does not have all power.
  - God's all-power is the **<u>strength</u>** of all of His other attributes.
  - It is His power that gives you and me our **<u>faith</u>** and <u>**confidence**</u>.
- 3. You and I have **<u>peace</u>** because our God has all-power.

Now as we study this power, we must see God has two types of power:

- Ordained power means He has the absolute right to act.
- <u>Absolute</u> power means He has the <u>ability</u> to act.

Question: What gave God the right to create the universe?

Answer: His ordained power or simply He is God.

Question: What gave God the ability to create the universe?

Answer: His absolute, without measure, infinite **power**.

#### Colossians 1:16

What does omnipotence mean to me as a Christian?

• First – I can **overcome** sin by His power.

# 1 Corinthians 10:13

- Don't ever believe that there is a sin you cannot overcome; that is a <u>lie</u>. Freedom comes in His <u>power</u>.
- Secondly, it means I can <u>overcome</u> demonic forces and <u>rebuke</u> Satan and every demon by standing in God's power/authority of Jesus Christ.

# 1 John 4:4

5. No created being will ever be **greater** than its Creator.

Let me tell you a truth regarding God's power – God and Satan are not **fighting**. I am fighting; I have been given God's **power**.

That's what it means omnipotent is God is in **complete** control.

• Third – He strengthens my physical body to be able to <u>accomplish</u> His will.

#### Romans 8:11

 The fourth meaning of omnipotence – God's power is present to <u>witness</u>, <u>heal</u>, and <u>minister</u> through you and me.

Now here is the second thing about God:

#### B. God is **omniscient**.

Remember:

Omni – <u>all</u> Science - <u>knowledge</u>

Definition: God knows **<u>everything</u>**, everything <u>**actual**</u>, everything **<u>possible</u>**, all <u>**events**</u>, and <u>**creatures**</u> past, present, and future.

- God knows all at the **<u>same</u>** time.
  - If God didn't know everything (past, present, future) then when He learned of something future, He would have to <u>change</u> – God doesn't change because He <u>knows</u>.
- 6. God can never <u>learn</u> anything because He already knows <u>everything</u>.
  - God is never trying to figure something out, He is never <u>bewildered</u>, He is never <u>confused</u>; He never <u>wonders</u> what to do hoping an idea will come to Him.

Question: What does God omniscience mean to me as a Christian?

Answer: Nothing will ever catch God by <u>surprise</u>, and He has <u>planned</u> and <u>provided</u> for me and my family to be able to walk through what comes up.

Let me show you God's omniscience in scripture:

Job 38:1-2

Job 38:3-11

Job 38:19

Job 38:22

#### Job 38:25-26

I can trust God – He knows it **all**; He knows **me** and knows my **path**.

Here is the third thing:

#### C. God is **omnipresent**.

Definition: God is fully present at all places, at all times.

Present – means <u>close</u> to you, very <u>near</u>, right next to you, I am <u>here</u>.

- God is everywhere <u>at once</u>. There is no <u>limit</u> to where He can go because He is infinite without limit or measure.
- God doesn't travel because the reason you travel is to get <u>somewhere</u> you're not at.
- This is the **<u>omnipresence</u>** of God.

 God is above all-<u>presiding</u>; He is beneath all-<u>sustaining</u>; He is outside of all-<u>embracing</u>, and He is inside of all-<u>filling</u>.

You know where He is?

Is He outside of me or inside? **Both** 

Is He above or beneath me? Both

# 2 Chronicles 2:6

We think the universe contains God – it does not, but He is there.

- Here is the **<u>bigness</u>** of God
- Scientists have found stars 300 million light years away

   it does not contain the bigness of our God.
  - \*\* When you come to Church and fill the Kleenex cartons, God is **<u>there</u>**.
  - \*\* When you are tempted to sin God is **there**.

Let me ask you this: If when you are tempted, God says, I am about to show up, would you do it?

Surprise – God is <u>there</u>.

Psalm 139

- There are <u>24</u> verses
- The **<u>24</u>** verses are divided in sections of four.
- The first show the omniscience of God showing He is all-**knowing**.
  - 1-6 **Omniscience** of God
  - 7-12 show the **<u>omnipresence</u>** of God
  - 13-18 show the **<u>omnipotence</u>** of God
  - 19-24 show God's justice.

Psalm 139:13-18 - Omnipotence

What does this mean to a Christian:

- In His power, you have victory
- In His knowledge, He knows what you need.
- In His presence, you are never **<u>alone</u>**.
