This Is The Beginning And Not The End

Be Comforted

Do not fear failure, but be terrified of **regret** – rise up Church

About <u>30%</u> of the Bible is prophecy and most of it relates to the times we are living in.

In the next two weeks, I want to make three statements to comfort you.

Regarding what is happening in our world:

A. This is not **the end** – be comforted.

Church family – many of you have asked are we in tribulational times?

Answer: Absolutely not

Revelation 6:7-8 – speaks of one of the horsemen

• That would be **two billion** people who died.

Question then is: what in the world is going on?

Let me answer that question in two ways.

First: Let's look at Bible prophecy

Matthew 24:3-6

Matthew 24:7-8

 We are in the beginning of sorrows and I believe it started in <u>1948</u> when Israel became a <u>nation</u>.

Turn to Luke 17, and Jesus is addressing the signs of the end and Jesus is extremely specific:

Luke 17:20-24

Verse 24 speaks of the second coming – it will be like lightning – a **flash** to receive His Church.

Luke 17:25

Luke 17:28-30

- There was a historical day in the day of Noah
- There was a historical day in the day of <u>Lot</u>.

Verse 30 again:

Luke 17:30

Luke 17:31-37

The second coming of Jesus is a very **physical** event at the Mount of Olives.

- At the second coming or Advent Jesus comes to the earth publicly.
 - 2. The Rapture is a **<u>private</u>** event that happens in the air and Jesus receives His Church.

Jesus compares His coming to the historical day or the event of **Noah** and **Lot**.

Question: What are the similarities?

- <u>Violence</u> and <u>immorality</u> covered the earth in those societies as of today.
- Business as usual with <u>economic</u> and <u>social</u> normalcy.

This too will pass.

- Jesus was being specific with the desire to comfort us saying these things take place in <u>seasons</u> – don't fear. There will be life and an economy when Jesus finally returns.
 - Third similarity is a righteous remnant living in a corrupt and unrepentant world – that's us.
 - Fourth is the sudden rescue of the righteous before the wrath of God falls.

Let me put another layer of truth to comfort you today.

- The day Noah got on the boat – people were given in **marriage**, **buying** and **selling**.

The Rapture is before all this.

Noah and his family got on the Ark not one <u>rain drop</u> hit their heads – then destruction came.

Rapture of the Church is like <u>Lot</u>.

Jesus said on the day of Lot – He <u>walked out</u> of Sodom and then destruction came to Sodom and Gomorrah

Rapture of the Church – then <u>the Tribulation</u> (we won't be here)

Before this happens, there will be business, marriage, family.

Rise up Church

 Set the atmosphere of <u>victory</u> in your homes, fathers and mothers – Jesus is <u>risen</u> Question: Why did Jesus say in that day – some will sleep and some will be working the field?

Half of the world right now, it's **night** as we are in our daylight.

The point is, **be ready**.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

 The Rapture – your great grandma's spirit is with Jesus and she will come with Jesus in a new, glorified body.

This glorified body comes out of the **ground** and we who are alive will be caught up and meet in the clouds in the **air**.

People say: rapture is not in the Bible - Yes it is

Caught up – Greek word: harpadzo

Harpadzo – means to **seize hastily**

Our end is Jesus comes and gets us!

1 Thessalonians 5:2-3 – unbelievers

1 Thessalonians 5:4-8 – believer

- When the Bible says Jesus comes as a <u>thief</u> in the night, that's to the <u>unbeliever</u> who don't believe in Bible prophecy.
- 5. Jesus said to us the believer, be <u>aware</u> of the signs of the times, walk in great confidence and faith God's plans will <u>manifest</u>.

The next words I will read are very critical for you to see.

1 Thessalonians 5:9-11

God has not appointed you and me to wrath.

Revelation 6:14-17

* The wrath of the Tribulation is the wrath of Jesus called the **Lamb**.

1 Thessalonians 1:10

The Tribulation is not judgment, but <u>wrath</u> – you and I will not **experience** His wrath.

Reimagine who you are and what we do – walk in His grace, receiving His blessing – do not fear, God's plans will manifest in those who **seek** Him.

Let me close with this...

Luke 21:34-36

Acts 2:17

Let's **position** ourselves in the beginning of sorrows – to receive the **power** of the Holy Spirit and walk in **victory**.
