Rules of Servanthood – S.E.R.V.E.

S – Serve what your spouse needs in spite of what you need, want, or understand

E – Enjoy serving your spouse, and do it with a joyful attitude

R – Reject score keeping, and do what you do with a spirit of grace and faith.

V – Vigilantly protect the priority of your marriage and the time and energy to serve your spouse

E – Expect to be blessed and don't get discouraged Matthew 23:11-12
